SENIOR SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The OCUSBC Senior Singles Tournament opens July 25, 2015 and Closes July 26, 2015.
2. All entries will be scheduled in the order they are received. If you wish to bowl together, please send the entries in the same envelope. On-site entries will only be accepted with lane availability.
3. Positively no refunds will be given once the prize money is listed.
4. Only members of the Orange County USBC Association that are 50 years of age or older as of July 26, 2015 will be allowed to bowl in this tournament.
5. This Tournament shall consist of a four (4) game singles event.
6. Entrants may bowl only once in this tournament. Averages will be used in the order as listed below.
 - 1) 2013 – 14 OCUSBC Book Average as of May 31, 2014.
 - 2) 2014 – 15 OCUSBC Book Average as of May 31, 2015.
 - 3) 2014 Summer league average.
 - 4) Highest current league average of 21 games or more. If no acceptable averages are submitted, an average of 220 will be assigned. **Rule 202 applies.**
 - 5) Any bowler who bowls in a ‘challenge’ league, or any other league that bowls on a sport condition, but does not certify with USBC as a sport league, will be subject to re-rating by the Tournament Director as deemed necessary by the OCUSBC Tournament Committee.
7. Previous winners of OCUSBC certified tournaments may be given a “Tournament Average” at the discretion of the Tournament Director based on previous scores bowled in competition.
8. This will be a handicap tournament with handicap to be 90% of 220. Entrants will be classified by their gender and age as of July 27, 2015 as follows:

Super Senior	75 & over
A Division	70 - 74
B Division	65 - 69
C Division	60 - 64
D Division	55 - 59
E Division	50 - 54

The minimum age to compete in this tournament is **50 years of age**. Date of birth **must** appear on entry form.
9. No absentee or vacancy scores will be allowed. Bowlers that are late will receive zero pins for each frame missed. No makeup of frames or games will be allowed. If a bowler refuses to start promptly for any reason, tournament management, at its sole discretion, may declare the game(s) forfeited with a score of zero.
10. Any scoring errors must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the end of the series or the score will stand. Any protest concerning an error in calculation of scores in the tournament must be made within 15 days after the publication of the prize list.
11. The Prize fund will be returned 100% in a ratio of one prize for each 6 entries in each division.
12. **WINNERS IN EACH AGE CLASSIFICATION RECEIVE A FREE ENTRY INTO THE 2016 CUSBC SENIOR TOURNAMENT. ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID BY THE BOWLER TO CUSBC AND WILL BE REIMBURSED TO THE ENTRANT UPON PROOF OF PARTICIPATION.**
13. The following articles of clothing will not be permitted: tank tops, halter tops and cut off or bicycle shorts. Participants are requested to wear garments in good taste and appropriate for tournament bowling.
14. This tournament will be certified by the United States Bowling Congress.
