OCUSBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

YOUTH DIRECTORS: GUARANTEED ENTRY CLOSING DATE IS FEBRUARY 1, 2019.

1. **FEES:** Remit ONE Personal check, money order, or Center certified check for the total fees. Make payable to OCUSBC. Fees must be remitted to cover the events listed. Entry fee is \$25.00 per bowler, per event. (Fees are not refunded once the schedule and prize list are prepared). There will be a \$25.00 fee for all returned checks.
Prize Fund \$12.00 Expense \$1.00 Lineage \$12.00
Credit cards are now accepted by calling the OCUSBC office.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** This tournament is open to all USBC youth bowlers. Each entrant **MUST** have OCUSBC certified league average (see #5).
 - a. Bowlers will be allowed to enter multiple times in team and doubles/singles events.
 - b. Bowlers entering doubles must also enter singles and vice-versa.
 - c. Bowlers whom bowl multiple times with same team members or doubles partner may only cash once in that each event.
 - d. Bowler entering in singles event multiple times may only cash once.
 - e. Bowlers entering multiple times in all-events may only cash once.
3. **AVERAGE:** Average must be established in an Orange County USBC youth certified league. Use the average in the order given below.
 - a. The highest winter/summer average from 2017-18 season with a minimum of 21 games.
 - b. January 1, 2019 average minimum of 18 games.
 - c. Current league average as of February 16, 2019 with a minimum of 12 games.
 - d. If none of the above, the bowler will enter at 200.
 - e. League sheet based on games listed above needed for 2019 must accompany entry.

Note:
USBC Rule 319a Conditions that Apply
USBC Rule 319b Assigned Average
USBC Rule 319c (re-rating) will be enforced as necessary
USBC Rules 319d and 319f will be waived
USBC Rule 319a (3) will be enforced (failure to report correct average)
USBC Rule 201 applies (sport average adjustment) and will be enforced as necessary
Any bowler who bowls in a 'challenge' league, or any other known league that bowls on a sport condition, but does not certify with USBC as a sport league, will be subject to re-rating by the Tournament Director as deemed necessary by the OCUSBC Tournament Committee
5. **HANDICAP:** Bowlers will receive 90% of 200 for each event, including All-Events.
6. **SUBSTITUTES:** OCUSBC assumes no responsibility to provide replacements. Replacements for the original entrants may be made providing the replacement meets eligibility and average requirements and must take the place in the line-up of the original entrant. Replacement must bowl under his/her own name.
7. **TARDY PLAYERS:** Bowlers arriving late shall begin play in frame being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up.
8. **DELAY OF GAME:** If equipment failure on a pair of lanes would delay the progress of the series, a tournament official can authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of certified lanes. The interrupted game and series must be resumed from the point of interruption. No practice will be allowed after being moved. See USBC Rule 321.
9. **SLOW BOWLING:** OCUSBC has allotted 3 hours for team and for doubles/singles to be completed. Except for those caused by lane breakdown (#8) no unreasonable delays will be permitted. Please be ready to bowl when it is your turn. Advise a scorekeeper if a bowler must leave the lanes, otherwise bowler may be given a zero for that frame and might be subject to disqualification. This will be determined at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
10. **RE-RACKS:** Each bowler is allowed a total of one re-rack per series. Additional re-racks may be granted by Tournament Director.
11. **SCHEDULE INFORMATION:** Entries will be given preference in the order in which they are received.
 - a. When all squads are filled, the next available date will be assigned.
 - b. Teams wishing to bowl together must submit entries together.

- c. Group reservations may be made, but **FULL** payment of entry fees **MUST** be submitted no later than 2 weeks after reservations are made or the spots will be forfeited.
 - d. Bowlers will bowl doubles first. If one bowler is late for the doubles event, the entrant present will bowl singles event first
 - e. In the event of a tie for 1st place, co-champions will be declared.
12. **PRIZE FUNDS:** At least one (1) award will be given for every eight entries.
- a. A one-hundred-dollar (\$100.00) scholarship will be awarded to the 1st Place All-Events winner.
 - b. All winnings will be deposited into the youth bowler's SMART account with USBC.
13. **BOWLING ATTIRE:** All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No sexual, alcohol, tobacco or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. NO tanks tops or bare midriffs, halter tops, sweats, spandex, "cut-offs" or short shorts, no jeans or slacks with holes, no hats of any kind allowed. Walking shorts, "skorts" and skirts are permitted. Tournament Director shall determine the validity of any complaints.
14. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:** While participating in scheduled events, a bowler may be disqualified immediately for the following:
- (1) An infraction of the rules
 - (2) Delay in bowling
 - (3) Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the tournament venue. Individuals are subject to ejection for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including but not limited to physical and verbal abuse toward other persons.
 - (4) Being under the influence of liquor or drugs
 - (5) Use of a foreign substance(s)
 - (6) Use of a false average
 - (7) Failure to comply with the dress code
15. **PROTEST:** Any protest must be made in writing within 72 hours at the time of infraction to Tournament Director. See USBC Rule 329a (1).
