ONSITE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AS SPACE PERMITS.

1. **FEES:** Remit One(1) personal check, for the total fees. Make payable to OCUSBC. Fees must be remitted to cover the event fees listed. Entry Fee is \$60.00 per Doubles Team (Fees are not refunded once the schedule and prize list are prepared.) There will be a \$25.00 fee for all returned checks. Prize Fund \$33.00 Expenses \$3.00 Lineage \$24.00 per Doubles team.
Credit Cards are now accepted by calling the OCUSBC office.
2. **OPTIONAL SCRATCH EVENTS:** We are offering the following scratch events: Double \$20.00 (\$10.00 per person) 100% returned as prized fund.
3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Each entrants MUST be member of the OCUSBC with an Average (see#4) bowling in a OCUSBC certified league.
 - a. Bowlers will be allowed to enter multiple events.
 - b. Bowler who bowls multiple times with the same partner may cash only once with that partner.
 - c. Bowler bowling in multiple events with different partners may cash with each different partner.
 - d. Only One PBA/PWBA professional bowler per team permitted.
4. **AVERAGE:** Entering average must be established in an Orange County certified league. The highest of the following averages will be used in the following order:
 - a. OCUSBC tournament composite based on the last 12 Mixed Doubles games bowled or OCUSBC winter/summer average from 2018-19 season with a minimum of 21 games.
 - b. Winter/summer average from 2017-18 season OCUSBC league average with a minimum of 21 games.
 - c. Current average from 2019-20 with 15 games. League sheet must accompany entry.
 - d. If none of the above the bowler will enter at 220.

Note:

USBC Rule 319a Conditions that Apply.

USBC Rule 319b Assigned Average.

USBC Rule 319c (re-rating) will be enforced as necessary.

USBC Rule 319d and 319e will be waived.

USBC Rule 319a (3) Will be enforced (failure to report correct average).

USBC Rule 201 applies (sport average adjustment) and will be enforced as necessary. Any bowler who bowls in a 'Challenge' league, or any other known league that bowls on a sport condition, which does not certify with USBC as a sport league, will be subject to re-rating by the Tournament Director as deemed necessary by the OCUSBC Tournament Committee.

5. **HANDICAP:** Doubles Team will receive 90% of 440.
6. **PRIZE FUND:** One (1) award for every Eight (8) entries.
 - a. Prize winner will receive a check, Thirty (30) day after the close of the Tournament.
 - b. In the event of a tie for first Place Co-Champion will be declared.
7. **SUBSTITUTES:** OCUSBC assumes no responsibility to provide replacement. Replacement for the original entrants may be made providing the replacement meets eligibility and average requirements and must take the place in the line-up of the original entrant. Replacement must bowl under his/her own name.
8. **TARDY PLAYERS:** Bowlers arriving late shall begin play in frame being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up.
9. **DELAY OF GAME:** If equipment failure on a pair of lanes would delay the progress of the series, a tournament official can authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of certified lanes. The interrupted game and series must be resumed from the point of interruption. No practice will be allowed after being moved. See USBC Rule 321.

10. **SLOW BOWLING:** OCUSBC has allotted three (3) hours to bowl the entire Three-game set. Except for those caused by lane breakdown (#9), no unreasonable delays will be permitted. Please be ready to bowl when it is your turn. Advise a scorekeeper if a bowler must leave the lanes, otherwise bowler may be given a zero for that frame and might be subject to disqualification. This will be determined at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
11. **RE-RACKS:** Each bowler is allowed a total of one re-rack per series. Additional re-racks may be granted by Tournament Director.
12. **SCHEDULE INFORMATION:** Entries will be given preference in the order in which they are received.
 - a. When all squads are filled, the next available date will be assigned.
 - b. Mixed Double Team wishing to bowl together must submit entries together.
 - c. Group reservations may be made, but FULL payment of entry fees MUST be submitted no later than two weeks after reservations are made or the spots will be forfeited.
13. **BOWLING ATTIRE:** All Bowlers must wear suitable attire. No sexual, Alcohol, Tobacco or Profane Advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. NO TANK TOPS, HALTER TOPS, SWEATS, SPANDEX, "CUT-OFFS" or SHORT SHORTS, of any kind allowed. Walking Shorts, "Skorts" and skirts are permitted. Tournament Director shall determine the validity of any complaints.
14. **CERTIFICATION:** This Tournament is certified by USBC.
15. **DISQUALIFICATION:** While participating in scheduled events, a bowler may be disqualified immediately for the following:
 - a. An infraction of the rules.
 - b. Delay in bowling.
 - c. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the tournament venue. Individuals are subject to ejection for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including but not limited to physical and verbal abuse toward other persons.
 - d. Being under the influence of liquor or drugs.
 - e. Use of foreign substance(s).
 - f. Use of false Average.
 - g. Failure to comply with the dress code.
16. **PROTEST:** Any protest must be made in writing within **72 hours of the time of infraction** to Tournament Director. See USBC Rule 329a(1).
